

PROCEDURAL GUIDELINE – CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM

## SCHOOL'S VIABILITY

## 1. Background

- 1.1 In assessing applications for capital grants, the SAIS BGA Committee is required to be satisfied that schools seeking grants are financially viable. That is, schools must be likely to remain financially solvent and continue to be eligible, to receive recurrent Commonwealth funding at the site proposed for the facilities for the foreseeable future.
- 1.2 In South Australia, a school's eligibility to receive Commonwealth recurrent grants is dependent, among other things, on the school being registered with the Education Standards Board.

## 2. Guidelines

- 2.1 In assessing applications for capital grants, the SAIS BGA Committee is required to be satisfied that schools seeking grants are financially viable. That is, schools must be likely to remain financially solvent and continue to be eligible, to receive recurrent Commonwealth funding at the site proposed for the facilities for the foreseeable future.
